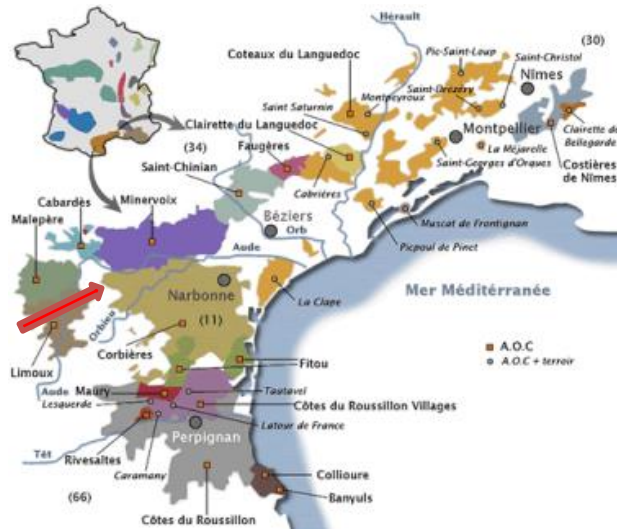


# Croix d'Or Chardonnay

IGP Pays d'Oc- France

**Croix d'Or** - This IGP wine comes from Languedoc-Roussillon (south of France). The area enjoys a classic Mediterranean climate with mild winters and hot, dry summers. Heat during the growing season is tempered by fresh sea breezes, which cool the berries and allow the berries to develop acidity alongside phenolic ripeness. Rainfall comes mainly in spring and in autumn, providing water to hydrate vines.

**Terroir :**  
Clay limestone

**Grape Varieties :**  
100% Chardonnay / IGP Pays d'Oc – Indication Géographique Protégée

**Vinification**  
Harvest at night (to avoid oxidation) Destemming of the grapes, Cold maceration. Vinification at low temperature (16°C) in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks.

**Tasting notes**  
Bright gold yellow with straw yellow tints. Fresh on the palate, its melon, pear, fig and crisp citrus flavors are deliciously rich yet refreshing. It has a good balance of sweetness and acidity, with a long, clean and fresh finish.

**Food Pairing**  
Best served at 10 to 12 ° CC. Excellent with seafood and fish dishes, white meats, and fruit desserts. This wine will also be very enjoyable alone as a relaxing drink
