

3 Pillars Pinot Noir "Los Carneros" 2019

The grapes for Three Pillars Pinot Noir come from the Los Carneros appellation located in the southernmost part of Sonoma County. A blend of three Pinot Noir clones – 115, 667 and Pommard . Starting before dawn, harvest begins in the early morning to preserve the fresh red fruit flavors. The grapes are then destemmed, soaked, fermented & pressed over 14 days. The wine is barreled down in French oak barrels for 11 months. The result is a classic example of "Burgundian" style Pinot Noir.

Pinot Noir oak regime: 25% New, 75% Neutral -- aged 11 months
