Clones: 777, 828, 115

Vineyard age: Planted from 2002 to 2005

Site: Located in the Petaluma Gap region; West facing hillside of Sonoma Mountain; multiple exposures.

Soils: Goulding Cobbley Loam

Yield: 2.3 tons/acre

### HARVEST

Harvest Date: September 14-18th, 2015

Harvest Brix: 24.5-25.5

Growing Season: A dry winter and mild spring set the conditions to surpass the notable 2014 vintage. Steady ripening and an early harvest of perfectly ripe, balanced fruit.

### WINEMAKING

Winemaker: Erica Stancliff

Hand-harvested grapes

Fermented with native yeast

Extended period of cold soak and maceration

Hand-punched cap, twice per day

Native malolactic fermentation in barrels

Aged 9 months in Damy, Francios Freres, Radoux, and Cadus French oak barrels; 35% new

Unfined and unfiltered
