
Each and every bottle has been hand harvested and hand produced.

Vineyard: Indindoli

Clones: Wente & Robert Young

Vineyard age: Planted from 2002 to 2005

Site: Located in the heart of Russian River Valley off of Vinehill School Road. Northwestern exposure.

Soils: Sandy Loam

Yield: 2 tons/acre

#### **HARVEST**

Harvest Dates: September 14, 2017

Harvest Brix: 24.0

Growing Season: 2017 delivered moderate weather conditions creating an ideal growing season. Cool mornings, sun-filled days and foggy evenings throughout most of August allowed grapes to ripen at an optimal pace. Flavors are harvest were exceptional, while maintaining acidity.

### WINEMAKING

Winemaker: Erica Stancliff

Night hand-harvested grapes

Immediately pressed whole cluster, overnight tank settled

Fermented in barrel with native yeast

Native malolactic fermentation in barrels

Aged 8 months on lees in French oak barrels, stirred once a week (25% new, 75% neutral), stirred 1x per week

Unfined and unfiltered
