Originally from the region of Bresse, Anaïs Pertuizet established her domain in Lantignié in 2021. After 5 years of studying viticulture and wine making, Anais worked in multiple wine regions around the world developing her style and organic, low intervention philosophy. Born and raised in a farming family Anais was pre destined to work & spend her time outside. Given the opportunity in Lantignié to take residence in her mentor's cellars she purchased 2.5 HA of vineyards laced in blue stone terroir to start her own winery. Accompanied only by trusty her side kick, Irokoi the Draft horse.

Farming philosophy: Organic & Biodynamic farming practices. Everything is done by hand, or by horse, no machine use. 3 year organic conversion

FARMING PRACTICES

- Training method : Gobelet
- · Less Copper and Sulfur than the Organic certification limits
- · Organic & biodynamic treatment (herbal teas & decoctions)
- Land worked only by horse
- Reduction of planting density
- Green harvest
- · Cover crops used every sixth row

Winemaking

- Hand picked grapes, hand sorted during harvest
- Whole cluster fermentation
- Light press for 4 hours
- Fermentation : Temperature-controlled, concrete tanks for 10 days
- · No SO2 added during vinification
- Fermentation malolactic: 6 days in concrete tanks
- Aging: 10 months, 50% in stainless steal & 50% in oak barrels
- · Fined: No
- Filtration: KieselguhrSO2 Total: <20ppm

Tasting notes

A light red wine with aromas of rose petals, exotic spices and incense. On the palate it is lively and elegant with persistent black fruit notes and a mineral finish.
