Winemaker's Notes

Meritage is a Bordeaux-style wine made from two or more of the red "noble" Bordeaux grape varietals (typically, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, and Malbec.) The term Meritage was trademarked in 1988 by a group of California winemakers who wanted to create a recognizable name for Bordeaux-style blends without infringing upon the Bordeaux (France) region's legally-protected designation of origin. The term Meritage (coined from "merit" & "heritage" and pronounced like heritage) was selected from over 6,000 entries in an international contest.

Tasting Notes

A beautiful integration of fruit and wood, this vintage is dark crimson in the glass, with aromas of blackberry cobbler and black raspberry reduction. Smoked bourbon cherry and baking spices fill the palate with a front forward tannin structure that lingers on smoky finish.
